

# Student Storyteller Audition FAQ Sheet - 2012

#### What will Student Storytellers do?

• Student Storytellers ages 8-18 will be performing at the Lone Star Storytelling Festival, in Frisco on **Saturday, October 20th, 2012**. These storytellers will share the stage with nationally and regionally recognized storytellers, and tell a story no more than 5 minutes long.

#### How are Student Storytellers selected?

Student storytellers will be selected by a panel of judges at the Frisco Public Library.

#### What needs to be on my audition DVD or YouTube performance?

- Have a parent or the school librarian record the student, telling a memorized story of his or her choice <u>no reading from books or scripts please!</u> Students may not use DVD performances from previous year's festivals!
- The story should be no more than 5 minutes long. Please do not record the audition outside.
- Make sure teller states his or her full name and the name of the story at the beginning of the audition.
- Write the students name on the actual DVD with a black Sharpie.
- Make sure to shoot the performance in an open space. Give the student plenty of room to move around ensuring they are not backed up in a corner.
- If selected, the students may use the same story they audition with to tell at the Festival, or they may select a new story available during the student teller orientation.
- Auditions must be recorded on a PC formatted DVD or a DVD that can be played in a DVD player. Students may also
  upload the audition to YouTube.
  - On the audition application form, indicate which format the student has selected (PC or DVD) OR indicate the YouTube URL.

#### How do I submit an audition?

- Pick up a Student Storyteller's Audition Packet at the Frisco Public Library from the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Teen room, or at www.friscolibrary.com. Frisco ISD students may also pick up an Audition Packet from their school library.
- Submit both the audition DVD or YouTube URL and a completed audition application form to the Frisco Public Library during the Library's regular business hours (Monday -Thursday, 10am-9pm; Friday Saturday, 10am-6pm; Sunday 1pm-5pm) between April 1 and May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
- If you do not have access to a DVD-compatible video camera, check with your school librarian!

#### What is the audition deadline?

• Sunday, May 6<sup>st</sup>, 2012 at 5:00pm. No exceptions!

# Will Student Storytellers be paid?

 No compensation will be paid to student storytellers, but they will receive up to 4 complimentary passes to the Lone Star Storytelling Festival (an \$80 value).

## What preparation is there for Student Storytellers?

Student storytellers must attend a minimum of 7 coaching sessions at the library during the summer/fall of 2012.

#### Will the Student Storytellers' performances be promoted?

 Biographical information will be requested from each of the student storytellers for use in pre- and post-Festival promotions.
